

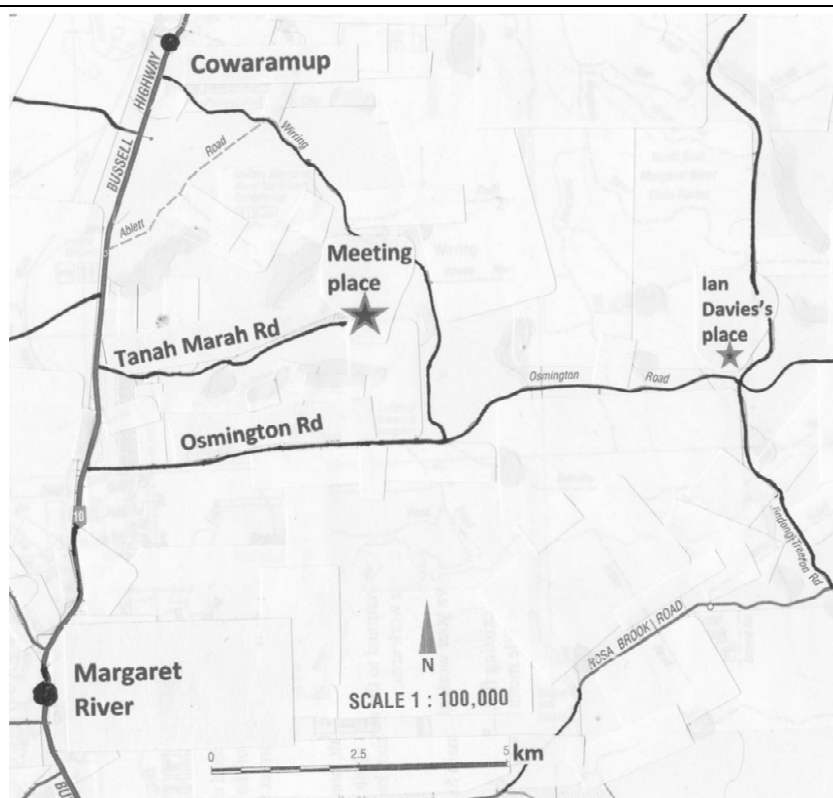
Options after harvesting bluegums.... & more
