Master TreeGrower Course

More than just a short course in trees on farms for farmers.....



Aim:	To assist farmers and others gain some of the skills and contacts to be able to use trees and revegetation in whatever ways suit their particular circumstances.
When:	Sometime between July and September 2017
Where:	Based in Northam with site visits throughout the wheatbelt.
Format:	8 days over 2 months. Much of the time is spent in the field.
Approach:	Not your usual short course – eg. it's non-prescriptive. Focus is on enabling participants to learn from local examples.
Topics:	Course will be tailored to suit local conditions and interests. Likely topics include, sandalwood, bush-foods, managing native vegetation, and trees for shelter, biodiversity, land protection and carbon storage.
Cost:	\$200 - to help cover cost of lunches and course materials. Day 1 free for those who'd like to come along to see if it's for them.
